- Application procedure
All the nominated students should create an on-line account and follow the instructions to prepare the required documents (application form, learning agreement, copy of the passport, English language confirmation, ID photograph) which should be sent to the International Office of UWr before 15th June (winter semester) and 31st October (summer semester)

DISABLED

PL WROCLAW01: Transcripts of records are issued by the International Office immediately after the examination period and handed to the incoming students before their departure.

2. Termination of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be amended by mutual agreement. The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.



